process researchers have struggled over the years; a major issue is the type and size of unit for process ratings In addressing the problem of choice of units in process research, Kiesler (1973, p 37) concluded that "in process research there are as many different units as there are distinct constructs requiring separate measurement"

Research Critique Process 1 Read the research article or report in its entirety to get a sense of the study and its contribution to knowledge development 2 Read the article or report again, paying attention to the questions appropriate to each stage of the critiquing process (Holder, 2003)
